

Relations to Philipps Family (Barons Milford of Picton Castle)

This line goes back to the third century over more than fifty generations. I am related in four ways: 1) marriage of Gwawr ferch Brychan Brycheiniog (b. 467) to Meirchion Brenin (King of) Rheged (b. 462). Their son was my ancestral cousin Llywarch Hen (534 - 634), Brenin Deau Rheged (King of the Southern Pennines); 2) Marriage of Rhys ap Bledri Latimer to Angharad ferch Llewelyn Ddiriad ap Rhys ap Tewdwr Mawr (b. 1084); 3) Marriage of Sir Aron ap Rhys to Gwenllian ferch Ednyfed Fychan ferch Rhys ap Gruffudd ap Rhys ap Tewdwr Mawr; 4) Marriage of Ieuan ap Madog to Catrin ferch Elidir Ddu.
