I enclose a report on the research output, 1982 to 1986, of the ex-department of chemistry at Aberystwyth and a copy of another request of mine for tenure at Aberystwyth. In view of these documents I request supervision by the Universities Funding Council, or alternatively arbitration or mediation, in my case vis a vis U.C.W. Aberystwyth.

I request this both as a scholar and U.K. citizen and taxpayer, additionally a member of an ethnic minority. In view of the guidelines and Acts of the European Parliament on the linguistic and employment rights of European ethnic minorities, I request greater fairness of assessment of my scholarly qualifications, and of my clear and ineluctable duties to the People of Wales. The Welsh Language is also an official language of the United Kingdom of Great Britain as a result of the Welsh Language Act of the Parliament of Westminster.

I request that a copy of the enclosed material be sent to the Minister for Education and Science for his personal views, and one further copy to the Prime Minister.
